Pre-Grad Activities (Grad Theme Week Parties)

- This week is not condoned, supported, organized or supervised by any employee of the Yorkton Regional High School.
 - Grad week consists of a week of theme parties, organized by students that any YRHS student is invited to attend (Saturday Saturday)
 - School does not sponsor or support this activity, it is not school organized
 - Grad Week has not been a long standing tradition, it has only been in existence for about 4 5 years
 - Each year, the graduating class is becoming more organized with the events of the week, wanting to "one-up" the previous years' grads
 - The professional teaching staff is concerned about the safety of our students as well as the type of influence the week has on academics, as some students are not functioning to capacity or to the best of their ability
 - Regular Curricular instruction carries on during Grad Week, exams do not get put on hold, and assignments are still due on due dates
 - If a student returns to school under the influence of alcohol and / or drugs the student receives an automatic 5 day suspension (if it is their first offence)
 - Timing is poor (finals)
 - There are many possible legal ramifications if hosting a party, if you plan on hosting a party, your best course of action would be to seek some legal advice
