# When is RCR?

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- RCR is called Period 7.
- Period 7 could be placed anywhere within the day, before Period 1, between any of the other periods throughout the day or at the end of the day after period 6.
- RCR could be as short as 10 minutes, up to an hour and a half or longer depending on the activity and agenda.
- An altered schedule is used to accommodate the RCR activity. It does *not* extend the length of the school day.
- It does not happen every day. It happens about 30 times throughout the school year.
- Attendance is taken at every RCR and it is an expectation that you attend.
- Altered timetables are printed and posted throughout the halls on RCR Days.

# What is RCR?

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RCR is an Advisory Class of grade alike groupings assigned to one Teacher Advisor.

Hypothetically you will be in the same RCR for your four years in High School.

RCR is a period meant to be educational, engaging, motivating and fun! It could include, but is not limited to, such things as:

- Talent shows
- Minute to Win It Activities
