The program is a work in progress. They are establishing the program. The school needed a place for our indigenous students to be. They established a “Room” – A1. They have made it “home”. It’s a busy place, all day, everyday. It’s busy before school, all periods of the day, RTIME, between classes and on lunch. The three ladies that work out of this room do home visits and phone calls / text messaging, building relationships with the families.

Supports offered: rides are arranged for the day, open before school for breakfast, “locker room”, time to identify highest needs for the day, Safe Landing Period in Period 1 – attendance / SPARK room, personal counselling throughout the day, and after school activities, peer mediation, Saulteaux, beading, drumming, jigging, mural painting, after school sports club, treaty Commissionaire presentation....grad wall in the works, a grand opening....more to be announced.

There has been an intern in the room, Louise Lulashnyk.
