

#### Commencement: Pre-Covid

- > Traditionally (Pre-Covid)1:00-3:00 Anne Portnuff Theatre
- Grads arrive at 12:00 for Cap and Gown prep
  - Rental Fee of \$25.00 must be paid by Friday, May 20<sup>th</sup>
- Traditionally Seating is limited in the APT
  - 4 seats per family (not counting your Grad)
  - No charge for attending Commencement
    - A ticket is required
  - Seat must be reserved in the Main Office by Friday, May 20<sup>th</sup>
- > Commencement shall be 'live-streamed' on the Internet

Flexihall & Catering (1200 tickets max) - \$2 increase per plate - 10% gratuity added	\$35 127.60
Restorex Fans	\$111.00
Decorating	\$1000.00
DJ & Sound System	\$3297.75
Total	\$39 536.35

# Pre-Grad Activities (Grad Theme Week Parties)



- This week is not condoned, supported, organized or supervised by any employee of the YRHS
  - Grad week consists of a week of themed parties, organized by students, that any YRHS student is invited to attend (Saturday-Saturday)
  - The teaching staff are concerned about the safety of our students as well as the type of influence the week has on academics, as some students are not functioning to capacity
  - Regular teaching instruction carries on during this week, exams do not get put on hold, neither do assignment due dates
  - If a student returns to school under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs the student receives a 5 day suspension (first offence)
  - There are many legal ramifications if hosting a party, if you plan on hosting such a party, your best course of action would be to seek some legal advice


