Highlights:

1. Penta system (reviewed this),
2. Implementation of new record/data keeping systems of Edsby, (Attendance and Markbooks)
3. had SLC's by Zoom, PENT 2 SLC Dec. 1, Penta 2 done Jan 7
4. staffing cuts among support, teaching and admin staff,
5. we are around 794 students,
6. we have \$19, 000, 000 upgrade happening,
7. estimated 165 to 180 grads but lots of fluidity because of Digital School fluctuation,

8. we have 16 visits to isolation room to date, Johnna reviewed what an isolation room is,
9. CSLC update – asked CSLA to “Stand in Line” – when the world returns to normal, we would like to be the host – CSLA taking our letter to their board meeting.
10. SRC Members reviewed some of this Fall’s activities: Remembrance Day, been working on Telemiracle project, Escape Room, Lip Sync, Kinsmen Project (extends from last year – grant from Kinsmen – will support paws and claws, making care packages), spirit days coming up, Christmas activities
11. Staff members put on a spirit week for staff while we were on Remote Learning,
12. PD Day we had a Staff Auction to raise funds originally for the Conference (raised \$1800),
13. Remembrance Day went very well – Powerpoint,
14. Ryan Hamilton former Raider received the U of R President’s Medal,
15. this year’s Yearbook will be limited of course,
16. Lockdown Drill upcoming,
17. enrolment is currently 794,
18. Attendance Policy is very different this year – we are taking a more supportive and informational approach than we have in the past,
19. big announcement yesterday that large high schools recommended to go to Hybrid learning, but due to our context, the GSSD decision has been to keep students attending every day.
20. We will be presenting the Learning Improvement Plan later in this meeting.
21. Many shout outs, Reviewed Edsby as attendance and Report Card,
22. Staff farewells as well as additions,
23. CSLC 2020 explained what “stand in line” for the next conference means and we are waiting on approval
