PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Motion: M/S/C SCC members endorse the additional clause “Students that are removed from a club or team due to disciplinary reasons shall forfeit their team fee. The remaining members of the club or team should not be placed in a situation where their experience is jeopardized due to the behavior of a teammate.” to the Student Code of Conduct.

2. Parking Tickets
 - a. \$10.00 tickets for improperly parked vehicles, vehicles in Handicapped parking, or in the fire lane, or for parking in reserved spots, parked on the grass
 - b. Fees go towards parking lot enhancements
 - c. Unpaid tickets get put onto student fees account – to be paid before graduation participation

Motion: M/S/D SCC members endorse the right for the security personnel to write parking tickets in the amount of \$10.00 each for vehicles improperly parked, parked in reserved spots, parked on the grass, or parked in the fire lane. Unpaid tickets will be added to student fee accounts.
