- a. COVID Update and Protocols

 - 1. Coaches / Advisors have permission to ask for “proof of vaccination” of the students in their club or on their team. They cannot take a picture of it or a photo copy of it.
 - 2. If proof has been shown that they are double vaccinated (after the 14 day period of having their second shot), they can continue to practice and play with the team/club so long as they are asymptomatic.
- b. Staffing
 - i. Approx. 15 new staff members: transfers, new hires, returnees, promotions
- c. Chief Cadmus Delorme – Spoke to our entire student body and staff on Day 2 of school, Mike invited him to speak to address what are we doing as a school to actually bring meaning to the word reconciliation?
 - i. **Message:** His message was well received...he had a car analogy, look behind you where we have come from, where we are presently at and where our headlights are shining, where do we need to get to? He spoke about his lost culture, through the generations...vertical versus horizontal history.
- d. Sept. 30 Enrolment TOTAL to date: 864 (includes DLS students attached to YRHS) + 50 or so new students.

- f. Graduation – comments on Grad 2021 – all things considered, went off very well. Some students preferred the “informality” of the outdoor drive-thru, it seemed to be more about “them”...they were given their limelight with chosen audience members.

CSLC 2020 – Update that we will propose CSLC 2023 Yorkton will host – however that is pending staff being “all in” – and if so, then it needs to go back to the GSSD Board to state our intentions. Again, we are “standing in line” waiting for a time in the future that we can host a “traditional” conference.
