  - o This is an addiction issue, a fine doesn't necessarily fix an addiction concern
  - Maybe missing an educational piece, is there opportunity to engage in support from an addictions counsellor?
  - If the purpose of the fine is to deter the vapers from vaping "in" the school, then that may make sense
