DRIVER EDUCATION AT THE YORKTON REGIONAL HIGH SCHOOL

Driver Education is a non-credit class that is offered to students at the YRHS free of charge. Successful completion of the course allows students to get their Learner Driver Permit through in-class instruction and in-car practice drives.

Get your registration form started (attached) and follow the steps. Completed registration forms should be submitted to the Main Office at the YRHS.

- STEP 1- Make sure you have identification. You will need a **BIRTH CERTIFICATE** and another piece of ID (Health Card, Status Card, Passport, etc.) See the **ESTABLISHING YOUR ID** brochure that is available at the Main Office of the YRHS.
- **STEP 2-** Take your ID into any SGI Issuer and ask for an SGI Customer Number. You will be asked to provide an email address. Best to write it down for them so they can type it in properly.
- **STEP 3-** Almost immediately, you will receive an email from SGI. This will have your mysgi activation code in it. Your mysgi account is required to write the exams. Set up your mysgi account within **15 days** as it will expire after that. Make sure you write down your username and password, so you do not forget them.
- **STEP 4-** Take time to go over the Saskatchewan Driver Handbook (available at SGI).
- **STEP 5-** Attend class with paper, pen, highlighter and a great attitude! Be sure to bring bagged lunch, snacks and drinks.

- Learner's Exam & Eye Exam will be done in high school during in class session.
- A student must be a minimum of 15 years of age to be eligible to have a Class 7 learner's license.
- If you are in the process of establishing your ID at the time of registration, submit your registration form anyway and provide your SGI Customer number to the Main Office as soon as you get it.
