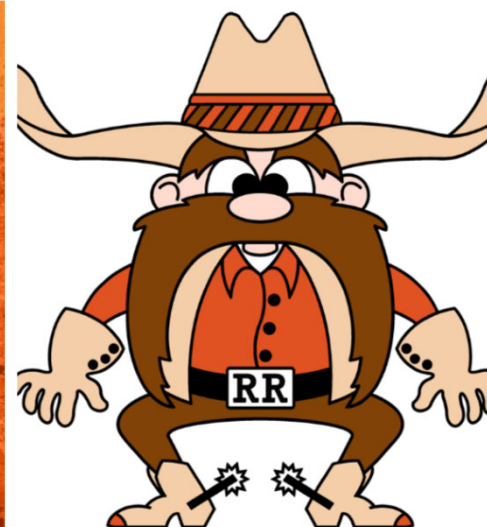




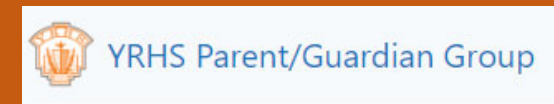

## Pathway to Graduation

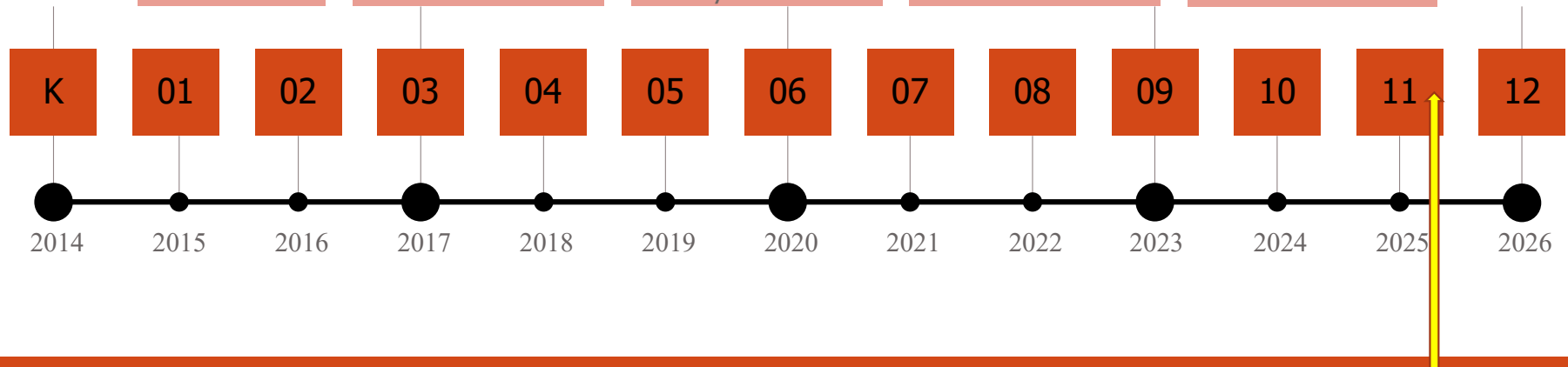
- Who was your Kindergarten Teacher?

- How were you feeling?

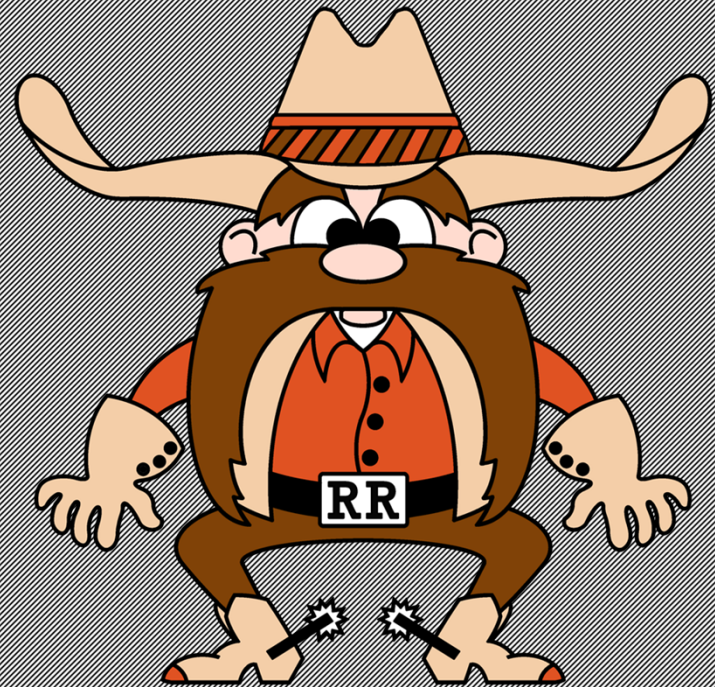
- How has your social circle changed since Grade 6?

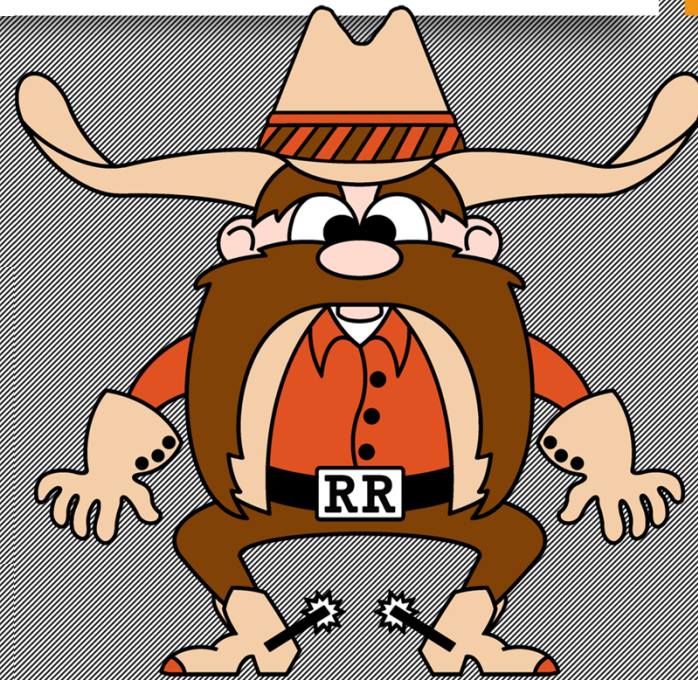

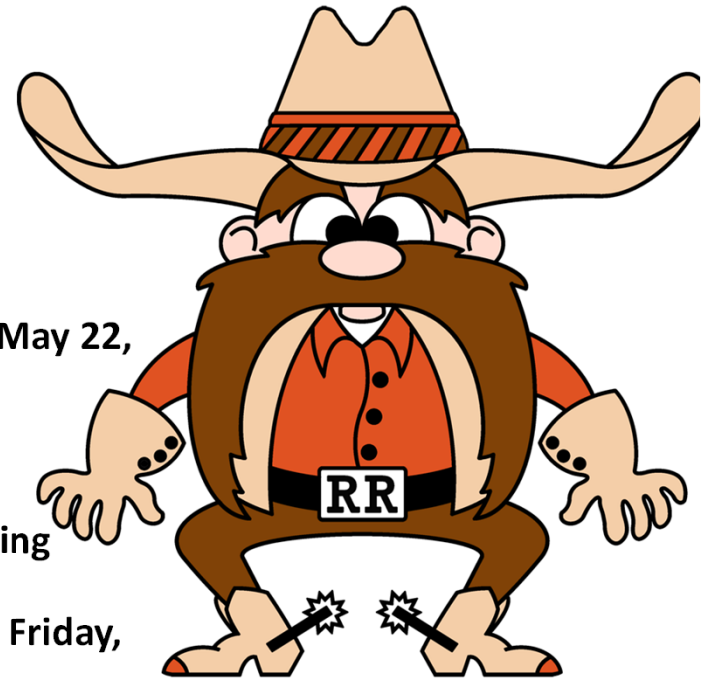
# Future Plans Survey for YRHS 2026 Graduates

- **Commencement: Thursday, June 25, 2026**

    - **Rental Fee of \$30.00 must be paid by Friday, May 22, 2026**
  - **Seating is limited in the APT**

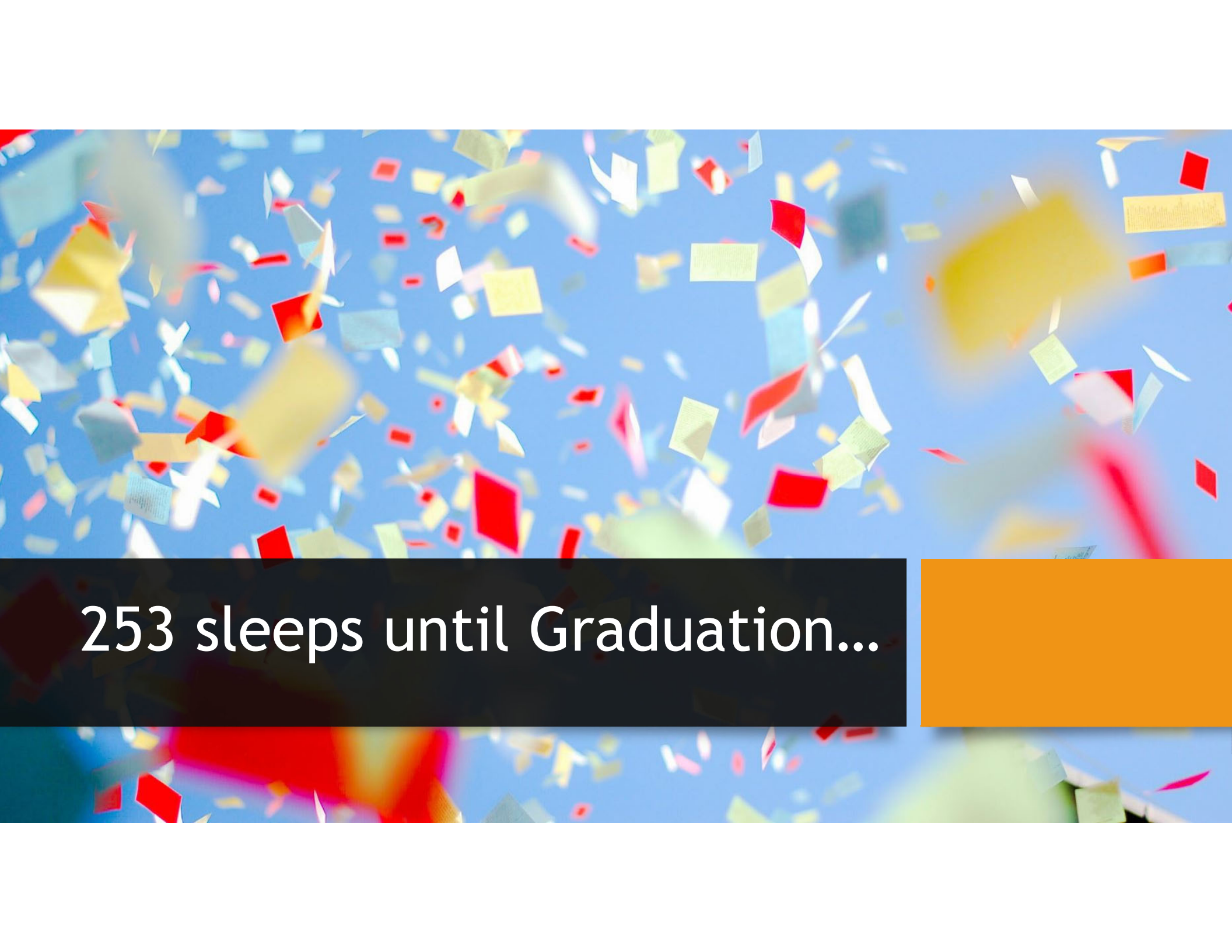
# Post Grad Activities

- Chem Free Grad

  - YRHS is not able to give out Graduating Student Names/Addresses

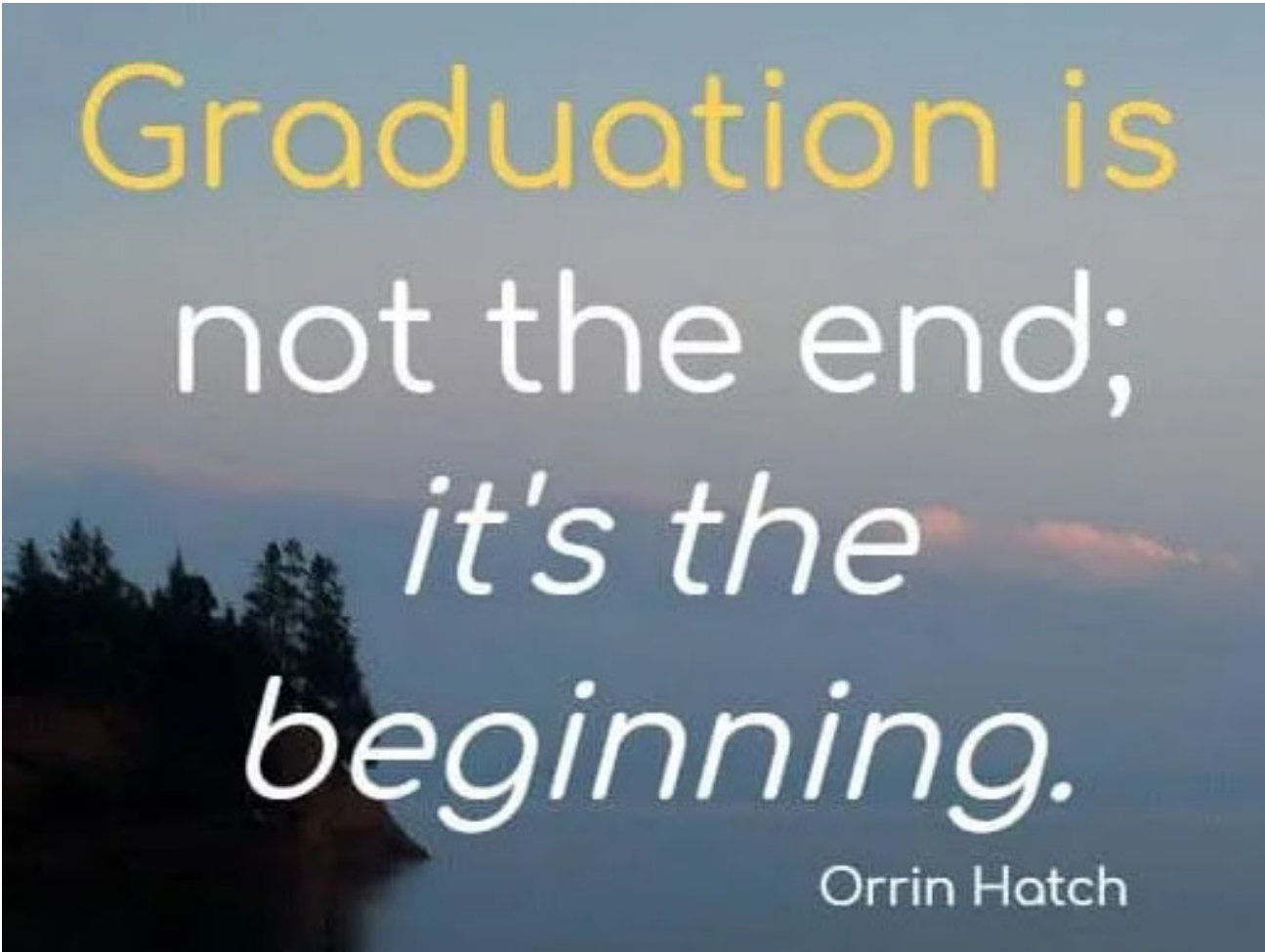
# Pre-Grad Activities (Grad Theme Week Parties)

- This week is not condoned, supported, organized or supervised by any employee of the YRHS
  - Grad week consists of a week of themed parties, organized by students, that any YRHS student is invited to attend (Saturday-Saturday)
  - The teaching staff are concerned about the safety of our students as well as the type of influence the week has on academics, as some students are not functioning to capacity
  - Regular teaching instruction carries on during this week, exams do not get put on hold, neither do assignment due dates
  - If a student returns to school under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs the student receives a 5 day suspension (first offence)
  - There are many legal ramifications if hosting a party, if you plan on hosting such a party, your best course of action would be to seek some legal advice
