Seating is limited in the APT


There will be a limit of seats per family

- This event would be planned for the same day, June 25, 2026


Safe Grad

- Traditionally this is what the YRHS has done
- Independently organized by the graduating parent/guardian body
- All meetings and organization of the event are not affiliated with the YRHS
- YRHS is not able to give out Graduating Student Names/Addresses

Pre-Grad Activities (Grad Theme Week Parties)

- This week is not condoned, supported, organized or supervised by any employee of the YRHS
 - Grad week consists of a week of themed parties, organized by students, that any YRHS student is invited to attend (Saturday-Saturday)
 - The teaching staff are concerned about the safety of our students as well as the type of influence the week has on academics, as some students are not functioning to capacity
 - Regular teaching instruction carries on during this week, exams do not get put on hold, neither do assignment due dates
 - If a student returns to school under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs the student receives a 5 day suspension (first offence)
 - There are many legal ramifications if hosting a party, if you plan on hosting such a party, your best course of action would be to seek some legal advice
